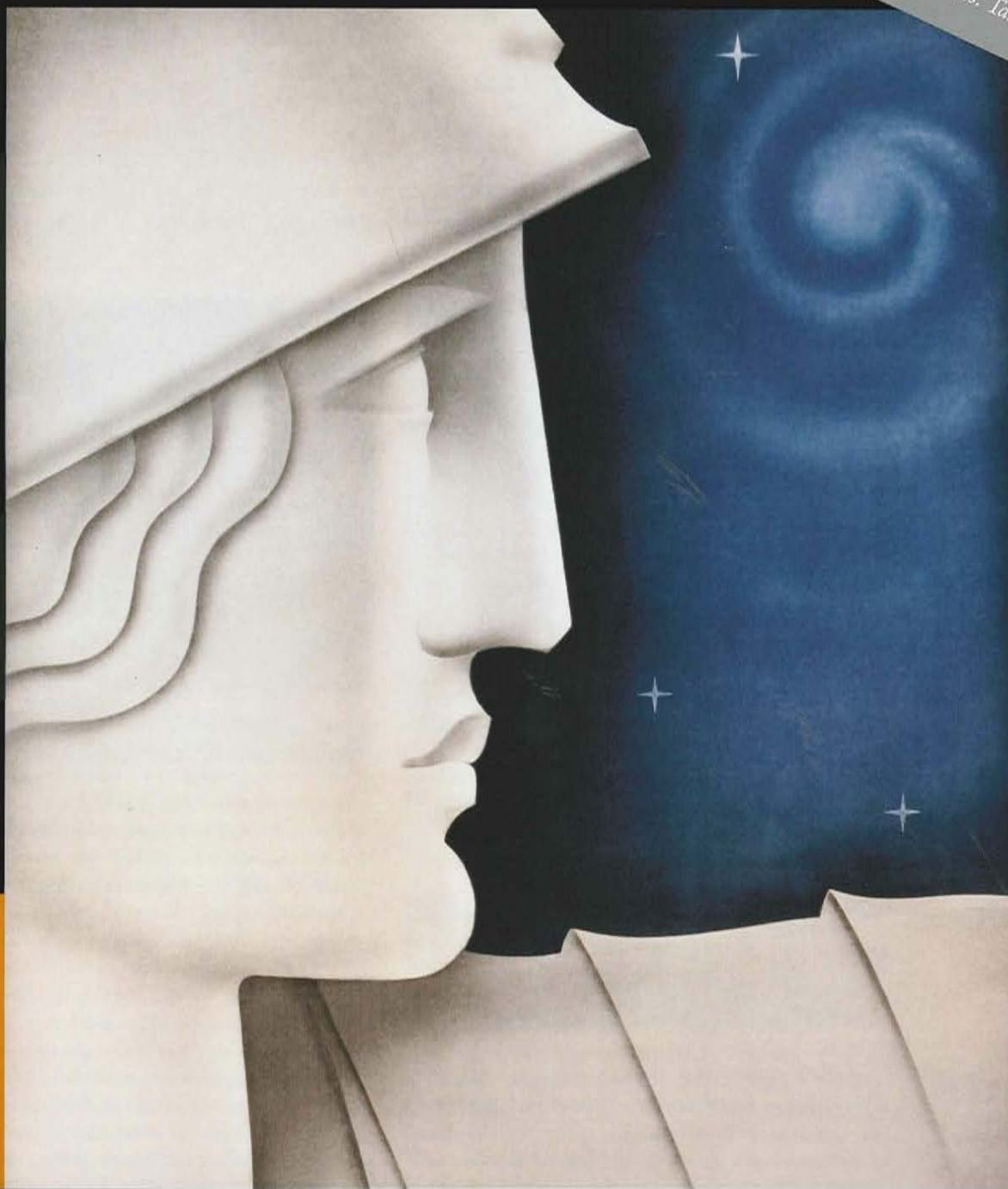

In the 1960s, the production of precast concrete panels was in its infancy—new forming, casting, stripping, loading, shipping, and erection techniques were being developed throughout the precast industry.
